**Clinical history:** Hypoxia.

**Findings:** The study is somewhat technically limited, but no abnormalities of the pulmonary circulation are evident.

There is very extensive bilateral pulmonary parenchymal disease with interstitial thickening and some small areas of consolidation, but without evident pleural fluid or hilar adenopathy. There is a suggestion of some lower lobe bronchiectasis.

The pulmonary findings are consistent with the clinical history of cystic fibrosis.
